On Friday 16th September 2016 ProCan was officially launched. I led the \$1.55M redevelopment of Level 5 of Children's Medical Research Institute in which ProCan is now housed. The redevelopment was completed on time and budget with an elapsed time of 7 months from the ACRF grant award to the commissioning of the redeveloped space.

I have been involved in web and system development work for Bicycle User Group (BUG) Bike North since 2010. In 2021 I developed a tool showing their rides/routes in a visual form, being a mashup of GPS data and online mapping tools. This tool used the Leaflet Mapping Library with Open Streetmap/Cyclemap with Leaflet Cluster Add-On and Glider.js, calling on Bike North custom Rides Database as JSON, and Bike North route data held in Ride with GPS.

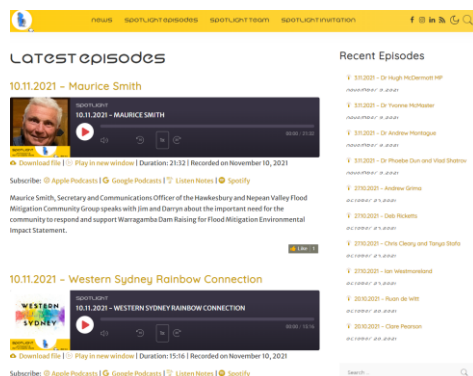

I was involved in Operations management since commencing work at CMRI in 2000. Initially this involved deputizing for the Operations Manager during periods of absence. In 2012, I took over day-to-day management of Operations activities.

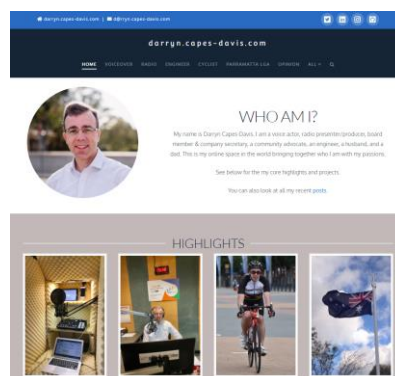
During my 20 years at CMRI my experience included:

- Building management including chilled water plant, hot water plant, air handling units, fan coil units, exhaust fans and the overall Building Management System (BMS).
- Maintaining systems and equipment in PC2 research laboratories including hoods, water systems, autoclaves and refrigeration, and including tasks associated with PC2 compliance.
- Work Health and Safety (WHS) systems and compliance, including pushing through a full WHS improvement plan during 2012 and managing the CMRI safety seminar series. CMRI was awarded the Western Sydney Annual Business Excellence Award for Excellence in Work Health & Safety (2016).
- Work Health and Safety (WHS) Training. In 2018 Darryn trained 4th year University of Sydney Honours Students (Medical School) in Work, Health and Safety. This consisted of creating four online training presentations and one 4 hour workshop. Content published under CMRI brand via Figshare

- Risk Management and Business Continuity work for the institute. Developed a Risk Management Framework for documenting and categorising risks at CMRI.
- Resources management for the Operations group, which included Scientific Support, Information and Communications Technology, Bioservices and Specialist Imaging. Each group had a manager who directly reported to the Operations Manager role.
- Equipment Alarm System design and construction – modification of an existing software solution to meet CMRI requirements, and implementation of the entire system.
- Managed a \$1.55M redevelopment of Level 5 of CMRI's Ainsworth Tower for the housing of up to 12 Mass Spectrometers as part of the ProCan project. CMRI was awarded \$10M from the Australian Cancer Research Foundation for this project.
- Managed the consolidation of Core Facilities at CMRI bringing together disparate Core Facilities under the one management structure, including the recruitment of General Manager, Core Facilities.
- Project Director for CMRI's Stage 2 Expansion Project where I was instrumental in developing opportunities for CMRI which led to the exciting concept of a partner building with Children's Hospital at Westmead. When I left CMRI the project was costed at > \$200M.

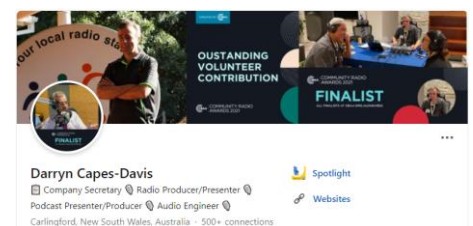
